What is Lightning Experience?

What's the difference between Salesforce Classic and Lightning Experience?

Lightning Experience is an innovative new interface completely redesigned from the ground up using the most modern technology and interface design principals. We've focused on what makes our customers successful and the features that customers want most to create Lightning Experience. With integrated AI, easier customization, and more tools than ever, Lightning Experience is designed to help you sell faster and smarter than ever.

Why is Salesforce transitioning users to Lightning Experience?

Lightning Experience is where all Salesforce innovation is happening. It's where you can find the best features and technology. Your org is well-positioned to take advantage of our optimized CRM experience.

What's the timeline for the transition to Lightning Experience?

Am I affected?

Yes. All users in your Salesforce org, including you, will be transitioned to Lightning Experience.

What happens if I don't do anything before the transition to Lightning Experience?

Are the features I need available in Lightning Experience?

Lightning Experience is packed with the features you need, as well as new tools, features, and technology that helps you be more productive, work more efficiently, and do your job more easily.

For most users, the biggest change is learning a new navigation system and getting comfortable with new page layouts. But don't worry. We've designed Lightning Experience to help you do more with fewer clicks.

If you can't find the feature you're looking for, click the "?" in the top right corner to get help, or ask your Salesforce admin.

Can I switch back to Salesforce Classic?

Yes, you can switch back until your org's admin disables switching between interfaces. Salesforce Classic isn't gone, but it's taken a back seat to newer technologies. You can temporarily switch back to Salesforce Classic by clicking your profile icon in the upper right corner of the Lightning Experience header, then selecting **Switch to Salesforce Classic**.
